Calgary is updating its [Water Efficiency Plan](#) to keep our city's water supply reliable as we grow and adapt to a changing climate. We are inviting Calgarians to share their perspectives on how we can support efficient water use and conservation.

Online engagement will be open from November 17 to December 7 at [engage.calgary.ca/waterefficiency](#). Feedback gathered through this process will help refine proposed programs, incentives and supports in the Water Efficiency Plan, ensuring it reflects community perspectives on water use and conservation.

Calgary's population and water demands have increased since 2005. While per-person water use has improved, total demand is climbing again and climate conditions are making supply less predictable. The updated Water Efficiency plan will guide how Calgary commits to responsible resource use to support a growing population, responding to a changing climate, and making water conservation easier and more accessible for everyone through future investments in programs, infrastructure and education.
